I) GENERAL ASSESSMENT OF THE VISITING OFFICER:

I	Any major complaint brought to the notice of the Visiting Officer: A Common grievance of people in the GP was that out of the fourteen (14) urgent public demands which were peened down in B2V1 & B2V2, only one (01) demand has been taken up and completed while the rest of demands are hitherto unfulfilled. As such people demanded that all such previous demands of B2V1 & B2V2 be fulfilled first.
II	Major/ urgent public demand(s) that was/were reflected earlier but have not been addressed so far: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> ① Upgradation of the health centre into a full fledged PHC with a Govt. building, availability of doctors 24x7 hrs and an ambulance service. ② Setting up of a lift irrigation plant so that the area can irrigate its paddy fields on its upper reaches. ③ Immediate improvement of existing HT/LT network especially the replacement of barbed wire and wooden poles at many places in GP. ④ Shifting of Higher Secondary School Midway to some other suitable location with sufficient land for a big play field.
III	Overall assessment of visit and suggestions: (The visiting officer to ensure that the overall assessment is recorded in detail along with concrete suggestions.) The panchayat body has not been elected in the gram panchayat (GP) which is hampering the routine functioning and execution of works in the GP, as such the GP needs elected PR's. Almost all the public services were found satisfactory, however some improvements are needed in services provided by departments like Health, PDD, R&B, P.H.E, RDD, Sheep Husbandry, Agriculture etc.
