01.	<u>Roads</u> - There is no road connectivity within Panchayat Halga - special to mention is that of chuntawari & Dangar Nar (4 wards - 1500 heads)
02.	<u>Drinking water</u> - The PHE has not taken any concrete step to do away drinking water scarcity of the area.
03.	<u>Ambulance</u> The Halga has not any ambulance facility as a result people have to fetch costly ferry (vehicle) in emergency.
04.	<u>Pending installment of IAY beneficiaries year 2012, 13 & 14.</u>
II	Major/ urgent public demand(s) that was/were reflected earlier but have not been addressed so far:
1.	<u>Road</u> - (A) up-gradation & construction of road from Sheikh-mugam to chuntawari to Irshad mode, be taken up by PMGSY. (B) Bandipora - Lolab road via Nagamarg be built.
2.	<u>Drinking water</u> - 4 inch = 300 pipes, 2 inch = 200 pipes, 1 1/2 inch = 300 pipes, 1/2 inch = 1200 pipes be installed in Halga Panchayat.
3.	<u>Ambulance</u> - At-least one ambulance be provided.
4.	<u>Nagamarg</u> - tourist spot be developed (Nagamarg, Nachi, Kemsar).
5.	<u>Committee hall</u> - for community purpose.

	The BSL programme was looked up with enthusiasm by people initially but follow-up means not much concrete has been done to solve people's issues. As a result, BSL has not left much interest in people to participate. It is of the observation, that at least road of chuntawari be build via Sheikh-mugam to Irshad mode be taken up by PMGSY. Further drinking water need be met by doing needful as mentioned in major/urgent public demands. Then only a trust may be developed among people.
