- (1) Irrigation Sector:- There is a level difference of main canal Tukab & main canal Kail, which needs to be kept uniform suitable so that irrigation water is passed through the canals.
- (2) R+B Sector:- Tahab - chakroora road is in dilapidated condit.
- (3) Education Sectors- Govt. High School be upgraded to Hr. Sec. Sch.
- (4) Revenue Sector:- Permanent Govt. building needed for Patwaris.
- (5) PDD Sector:- Detailed visit was conducted to village Bhatnay & it was observed that Electric lines are supported on trees & on low lying wooden sticks which poses threat to the residents of the village. LT poles are urgently required in village Bhatnay so as to avoid loss of life & property as there is an apprehension of the same - MOST IMPORTANT ISSUE.
- (6) Education:- 1. Requirement of Smart class for Govt. Upper Pr School Chandgam 2. Additional two class rooms needed.
