	<p>If comes to the notice of visiting officer B₂V₃ of GP Kuthyara that in both B₂V₁ & B₂V₂ (governance at grassroots), the issues of shortage of Medical Staff at PHC Jhati and Construction of new building of CHC Kudgrawn were raised but till date no action should be taken by his department. Public in general of GP Kuthyara very much annoyed with medical Department.</p>
II	Major/ urgent public demand(s) that was/were reflected earlier but have not been addressed so far:
	<p>Upgradation of pipeline from Daligoth to Gal, of length 9.0 km and also from Daligoth to Kudgrawn. As visiting officer, it is requested that these works can be started at the earliest so that the problem of drinking water in GP can be solved. Moreover, small water reservoir in each block of GP can somewhat fulfills the irrigation problems.</p>
III	<p>Overall assessment of visit and suggestions: (The visiting officer to ensure that the overall assessment is recorded in detail along with concrete suggestions.)</p> <p>During visiting in GP Kuthyara, I, Ajay Kumar Sharma, visiting officer mainly assessed that there is less number of Road connectivity with that Primary Health Centres / dispensaries no. are not enough to cater the needs of the inhabitants and above all drinking water facilities are not upto mark.
