I	Any major complaint brought to the notice of the Visiting Officer: It comes to the notice of visiting officer B2V3 of GP Kutthiyara that in both B2V1 & B2V2 (governance at doorsteps), the issues of shortage of Medical Staff at PHC Thatt and construction of new building of CHC Kudgrawn were raised but till date no action should be taken by his department. Public in general of GP Kutthiyara very much annoyed with medical Department
II	Major/ urgent public demand(s) that was/were reflected earlier but have not been addressed so far: Upgradation of pipe line from Daligoth to Gal of length 9.0 km and also from Daligoth to Kudgrawn. As visiting officer, it is requested that these works can be started at the earliest so that the problem of drinking water in GP can be solved. Moreover, small water reservoir in each blocks of GP can somewhat fulfill the irrigation problems.
III	Overall assessment of visit and suggestions: (The visiting officer to ensure that the overall assessment is recorded in detail along with concrete suggestions.) During visiting in GP Kutthiyara, I, Ajay Kumar Sharma, visiting officer mainly assessed that there is less number of road connectivity with that Primary Health Centres/dispenseries no. are not enough to cater the needs of the inhabitants and above all drinking water facilities are not upto mark. If these basic needs of the peoples are catered carefully their standard of living will definitely raise in the days to come. Moreover, the work of GRS is really praiseworthy as he is fully aware to introduce the peoples various schemes launched time to time by Govt. The team of Sarpanch & panches are young, generous and hardworking - work is satisfactory.
