- 4) Wornout electric poles and low height HT/LT lines, specially in Ward no-①, is a life threat.
- 5) No garbage disposal/collection system.
- 6) Problem in getting Ration Cards bifurcated.

II Major/ urgent public demand(s) that was/were reflected earlier but have not been addressed so far:

- 1) Shifting/Construction of new PHC
- 2) Construction of good network of drains
- 3) Route permit for Hakekal-Peerbaba-Satusari route.
- 4) Inclusion of wards falling in cantonment area under PMAY scheme.
- 5) Installation of Street lights, new electric poles and public dustbins.

As the area is not absolutely rural and is out of municipal limits, it is facing problems of inadequate roads, lighting system, drainage system etc. Hence, the panchayat area should be considered for its inclusion in Jammu Municipal Corporation for its overall development. Or otherwise budget allocation of Panchayat funds can be considered for an increase to meet the genuine demands of the residents of the area.
