

There is dire need of imparting trainings to BDC's , PRI members with regard to planning and management . The PRI members ought to work in a collaborative manner and must reach out to the common masses and under privileged with the schemes and national flagship programmes that are in vogue . It has also been observed that there is lack of awareness in the public about the schemes and incentives offered under various National Flagship programmes. Community Mobilisation programmes need to be organized at the GP level . The village being educationally , economically and socially backward needs much attention from the government for the benefit of general public .
