= During B2V3 it was observed that the people of this Panchayat Baddan A are very cooperative, loyal, hard workers, honest, dedicated and hospitable. All the demands which they have raised during Gram Sabha by the Sarpanch, Panch and prominent personalities are genuine and very important and may kindly be sanctioned for the development of the area. Various departments are working in the area but the works of RDD are appreciated viz PMAY houses, LD works etc. All the major developmental works are carried out by this department. All the people are satisfied with the works of ULW and URS. It is observed that the people, panchayat members are well aware about Govt. Schemes but more steps should be taken to aware them from time to time. The PHE officials are on strike are suffering badly without remuneration since long time. It was observed that in Gram Sabha some departments remained away, those who were present and represented department were unable to solve the basic problems of the people in Gram Sabha. The district officers are requested to visit the area by framing tour calendar so that some problems of the area should be resolved on spot. The roads are under construction. People of the area are particular about basic facilities like education, health care, safe drinking water, good roads, toilets for school girls and anganwadi centres. The area has good potential for tourism and Govt. should pay attention for promoting the tourism in Ramakunda & Dargah etc. The unemployed youths should be guided and trained for self employment schemes so that they can earn their livelihood. The Mahla Sabha & Bal Sabha should be organised regularly. Horticulture, Sericulture and Floriculture should be improved. The services of Public and especially sports and RDD departments are appreciated. In short it was a wonderful experience visiting this Panchayat.
