Message

Jammu and Kashmir continues to witness a transformation of Panchayat Raj Institutions ever since their constitution in 2018. Through the first of its kind initiative - 'Back to Village' - and the Government's decision of delegating funds, functions and functionaries to PRIs, grass roots democracy has flourished in the Union Territory. B2V3 is also an occasion to assess government functioning and service delivery through an unprecedented proactive Government-PRi interface.

I appeal to all Panchayat representatives as well as people to come forward and proactively participate in the program, thereby making governance more participatory, transparent and responsible.

I also urge the Deputy Commissioners to coordinate the visits of officers to various Panchayat Haqlas for better outcomes and ensure adherence to COVID SOPs while arranging various outreach activities.

I am confident that the people and officials alike will once again rise to the occasion and replicate the success of earlier B2V programmes.
