II Major/ urgent public demand(s) that was/were reflected earlier but have not been addressed so far:

① Availability of Pure Drinking Water to both the villages of Gram Panchayat i.e. Kannipure & Laroo, despite the fact that ex-MLA has provided Rs 25.00 lacs for pipe network work has been laid in village Kannipure, but hasn't been connected to the source.

② Electric wiring & poles work are in a very bad condition.

III Overall assessment of visit and suggestions:

No public demand of urgent nature highlighted by the people of the Panchayat in last two B2V Programmes has been fulfilled, except some works which have been undertaken by the RDP under MGNREGA.
