These demands are enclosed herewith this booklet for reference.

During my visit to the G. Panchayat, Baram I was observed that the govt. has taken every possible steps already for overall development of this taluqa, especially by developing basic infrastructure like road connectivity, lanes & drains, electric supply, drinking water supply, ICOS centres, schools, health dispensary etc. But more needs to be done especially in health sector by sanctioning a PHC in the G.P. for proper health care. Disposal of sewage is still a problem in G.P. In B.G.P. also, people have identified site 'Kadabul' for this purpose. Further, since agri. is mainstay of the people of G.P., irrigation structure needs to be built-up & strengthen to avoid losses of crops due to shortage of insufficient irrigations. Special attention on sports infrastructure building-up & activity of youth & children can help in building a healthy society & will help in proving sports talent lying with our youths. Some skill development programmes for youth especially women folk needs to be initiated on priority.
