- (1) It has been observed that there is no Public Transport facility available to the Panchayat Centre is of great concern. This problem/demand will require no funds to address and ARTO Kulgar may be instructed to do the needful with reasonable short. approve fares.
- (2) The people in general of Panchayat Bangurad 'B' are unaware of most of the schemes of different departments. As reflected in the awareness of Schemes they are ignorant.
