Surgeon, Anaesthetist, Ortho, Gynaecologist, physician Specialist etc are lying vacant in SDH DH Pora & the people demanded to fill these posts permanently so that people of the area are served in a better way. Gynaecologist, Theatre Assistant, 03000 deployed to DH Kulgan be called back to SDH DH Pora.
II	Major/ urgent public demand(s) that was/were reflected earlier but have not been addressed so far. 1. Filling up of vacant posts in SDH DH Pora especially Gynaecologist. 2. Replacement of filteration plant lying in dilapidated condition. 3. Up gradation of power receiving station. 4. Construction of road from H.S. School DH Pora to Degree College. 5. Construction of school buildings from J.S. Girls / M.S. Boys. 6. Construction of playground at DH Pora for which land already identified. 7. Construction of road from main road to Red sand. B2V2 8. Wildlife control room to be made functional. 9. Upgradation of electric transformer from 16.5 to 20 MVA at Nibati DH. 10. Subsidized of Anganwari Centre at Achara Mahalla.
