R/sir,

With due respect and humble submission, I would like to bring it to your kind notice the genuine grievances as well as demands of the people/voters of Gram Sabha Jaganoo for favourable action please.

1. Construction of Motor able road from Fukari Ser to Lower Trilla with bridge on Champal Nallah, since the people of Ser, Drull, Lower Trilla, and Lower Dhandal have to cover more than 20 km distance to reach at Block Head Quarter.
2. Construction of Motor able road from Girls High School Jaganoo to Samshan Ghat at river Tawi. As the people of Jaganoo, Ser, Marore, Patli and Dhalpar have to go for cremation at Samshan Ghat. But due to non availability of road they have to travel a long distance on foot. Besides the old people are not able to reach Samshan Ghat to perform the last rites of their relatives. If the stretch of 1.5 km is constructed it will be a big relief for people of above said villages particularly for the old people.
3. (a) Construction of circular M. road from Marore to PMGSY road Ser (b) M.road from Marore to Pattian (c) M.able road from Marore to the House of Jagdish Kumar.
4. Removal of the major Lacunae on the Jaganoo- Johnu upgradation road under PMGSY particularly rock cutting near Tawi Bridge, Bayian Morh Karowa and Champal Nallah, widening of lind curves and improvement of grades on required stretches.
5. Sanctioning of degree college at Block Jaganoo and introduction of commerce stream in Govt. HSS Jaganoo.
6. Sanctioning of water lifting schemes at Audey Bowly Jaganoo, Ser bowly, Thanda Nallah, Jaganoo bowly near Girls High School Jaganoo as this panchyat has been gifted number of bowlies by nature whose water remained untapped till today. If a separate water lifting

project is sanctioned for this panchyat we will be able to mitigate water crisis of this panchyat.

7. Sanction for full fledged laboratory, X-rays, Ultra Sound and as well as availability of Doctor (M.B.B.S) for 24X7 at PHC Jaganoo. Moreover, shifting of Block Medical Office and ICDS office at block head quarter Jaganoo which are already being run at tehsil head quarter Chenani.
8. Extension of Irrigation canal from Ser to Marore.
9. Sanction for ITI college for skill development for unemployed youth of our panchayat.
10. Release/ Sanction funds for construction of Block Development Council as well as BDO Office and Naib Tehsildar office at Jaganoo.
11. Transfer of Zonal Education Office Jib and Zonal Physical Education Office Jib from Udhampur to Jaganoo as 95% of schools belong to the Block Jaganoo. But unfortunately the office of the same are being run at Distt. Head Quarter Udhampur to suit the officers and the officials of the city. As the Government is more particular to provide the services at door step. So, these are to be shifted to block head quarter Jaganoo and the copies of schools belonging to this Zone is enclosed for ready reference.
12. Renovation of historical Fort Jaganoo for the promotion of tourism in our panchayat. As Jaganoo is a historical town located at a distance of 10 km near the bank of river to the east of Udhampur Distt. Head. Quarter. In days of yore it used to be an important Trade Centre and Traders from Jammu, Samba, Kathua and Amritsar would come here to stay and use it as a transit place to buy and sell their goods. They would send their goods to Ramnagar, Ghord, Chenani, Doda, Kishtwar and even to valley of Kashmir. Before 1920, it was the largest town in the Tehsil Udhampur and it had more than 100 shops. But after 1920, when Jammu & Kashmir BC road came into existence during the reign of Partap Singh the ancient town lost its importance and a large no. of traders shifted their business to Udhampur. The Jaganoo Fort built in the Mughal design, on a small hillock and serving as the impregnable boundary wall of the local Govt. Hr. Sec. School and declared as a protected monument by the Archaeological Survey of India. This Fort is believed to have been constructed by the Raja Suchet Singh in 1828. According to the

Rtd. Principal Sh. Bansi Lal Gupta that some funds were also spent for the upkeep and protection of this monuments. Meanwhile one of the walls of this fort has crumbled down due to incessant rain few years back. If repair and restoration work is not taken in near future the other wall of this majestic fort may meet the same fate and it may become difficult to restore the original shape of this historical fort.

Keeping in view the ancient history and glory of this fort it becomes imperative to have a big project in collaboration with ASI and Tourism Department to restore the original glory of this historical town.

If this project is sanctioned, it will be big boost for the economic activities for the traders and unemployed youth of this panchyat.

Hope for the early redressal of genuine grievances as well as demands of our panchayat.
