The students travel on foot by passing through forest area to get education at HSS Jagannad. It is being connected to the block then there is only 10 minutes from Jagannad Panchayat Ghar the Public is deprived of drinking water and shelter for irrigation especially ward No 3, 5, 6, 7, 5

(1) Length of road from Kumburi to Talamasa via PMSY Gaur.

(2) Connect of road from Gaur to Talamasa via PMSY Dept.

(3) Connect of road from Soken to Talamasa via PMSY Dept.

(4) Lifting of water from Vishal Tami to upper Panchayat for drinking purpose.

(5) Lifting of water from Kadi Sado (Tami) for irrigation.

Overall assessment of visit and suggestions (The visiting officer to ensure that the overall assessment is recorded in detail along with concrete suggestions)

The people of the Panchayat are honest and hard working, but due to the lack of facilities they are not progressing. The Govt should impart training to the people of Panchayat through PMSY programme so that they can become skilled and could start their business. There is a lot of scope of skill material & human resources but they need to be exploited. The best example for the same is LIT dip water together that I have seen. The farmer is not satisfied and earning is low. The road's such projects should be carried out by the other departments.

- ③ The H/S Upper Thanoo should be upgraded to Br. Sec. School.
