The beneficiaries of Gram Panchayat are satisfied by the developmental works executed at different places of Gram panchayat, However there is urgent need of Road Connectivity, as the people are facing lot of issues. They have to carry a serious patient or any pregnant lady on their shoulders. Water Supply Scheme existing in Gram panchayat was introduced in 1988, till date there is no upgradation of that. The pipes are having rust, too many leaks. Electricity System needs upgradation, lots of voltage drops as HT from D-H-pora needs immediate re-arrangement. As there is vast population One Branch of T&K Bank should be made available. There are less anganwadi Centers opened, Children are highly malnourished. The people belong to nomadic Community, Agriculture and Animal Husbandary department centres to be opened for them. Compensation for the owner of Panchayat Center to be given as they belong to poor and her husband died some years before.
