ward Satta was held on 12-12-2020 at Dadara village in connection with P.V. Programme. There are 11 wards in Panchayat helga Panchayat. Some prominent citizens from different wards like Post in the Satta. The members complained that their problems are not resolved. They are facing various problems, viz, old land roads are not properly maintained. The drains and bridges are also not maintained. There is irrigation well running through the village, which gets congested into 2 parts near Sheikh Pora Masjid and the two parts pass parallel through the village. The initial width was in metres.
