GENERAL ASSESSMENT OF THE VISITING OFFICER:

Any major complaint brought to the notice of the Visiting Officer:

I Some of nomadic families have expressed their concern about depriving them from benefit of housing under PAMV besides electricity and water connection. As such there is need to shift them - from forest land to govt. land and possibility of same be explored at an earliest under rules for their permanent settlement.

II Major/ urgent public demand(s) that was/were reflected earlier but have not been addressed so far:

1. Health Sub-Centre at Bidda.
2. Science laboratory at HS Bidda.
3. Compound walls in all three schools of Pyt.
4. Requirement of Udedu knowing teacher at MS Sucha.
5. Development of park and other tourism infrastructure near Bidda Baba Temple.
6. Demarcation of forest land.
7. Shifting of electricity - from Bhomag to Reasi feeder.
8. Fresh survey to cover leftover eligible families under PAMV.

III Overall assessment of visit and suggestions:

(The visiting officer to ensure that the overall assessment is recorded in detail along with concrete suggestions.)

Notwithstanding covid-19 threat, events of B2V3 prog. at Pyt Bidda were organised systematically following covid-19 schedule. Response of general public was low due to low covid-19 and non-addressal of some of the issues raised during previous versions of B2V. Further, funds allotment under B2V need to be enhanced besides placing funds at the disposal of other depts like Agriculture, Horti, Animal husb., Sheep husb., School Edu., Fishery etc for sustainable rural dev. Further more, Back-to Vill. prog. should be held once in a year at the close of financial year to make tangible impact.

14. Forest clearance / NOC be obtained in respect of road to be constructed by NHPC from Bidda to Soan.
15. Locals have demanded filling up of post of Patwari immediately.
16. CMO Reasi also made visit during B2V3 and matter of health sub centre taken up with him.
