	During Mahila Sabha, some generic issues were raised which needs to be looked into by them. Firstly there should be P.H. Health Centre with one nursing orderly. P.H. Centre in ward no 6 Panchli there are more 300 people. It is 12 km away from P.H. Hq. Salal. There should always be separate Sub-Health Centre to provide medical relief to these masses.
II	Major/ urgent public demands that was/were reflected earlier but have not been addressed so far:
	As mentioned earlier, that major demands of G.P. Salal kot during last two visits were:- Availability of P.H. Health Centre, Veterinary Hospital, Laying of Pipes for Drinking water supply, providing of electric poles etc. But unfortunately, these problems have not been addressed so far as reported by the Sarpanch, Panchs of various wards of G.P. Salal kot.
III	Overall assessment of visit and suggestions (The visiting officer to ensure that the overall assessment is recorded in detail along with concrete suggestions.)
	As it is well understood that topography of the P.H. is hilly one. water supply, power supply, Road Connectivity, availability of P.H. Health Centre, Veterinary Hospital at P.H. Hq. are the major issues which needs to be addressed so that people of the P.H. can feel more better and comfortable.
