Due to non-availability of roads in GP Mangota the downtrodden public faces so many hardship while carrying such & way disables our families. In the same way there is a frequent cut off electricity and a lot of households are yet un-electrified. The HT/LT wire cut/made and damaged which has to be changed & modified. The whereas the gravity line of water supply scheme in this too is fully covered by Rust by which water supplied to GP Mangota is very poor and unsatisfactory.
