I) GENERAL ASSESSMENT OF THE VISITING OFFICER:

Any major complaint brought to the notice of the Visiting Officer	
1	① Road connectivity to the villages in Pondichat block is very poor. People have to carry water to the travelling 4 km up and down the hill, but coming from back to Kusthal. ② Water supply to all roads is very poor. The main mains and pumps broken out of order. ③ This pondichat is rapidly growing a hand and an ATM. ④ The area is increasingly under the threat of monkeys who do a lot of harm, particularly to the crops of the poor cultivators.
II	Major/urgent public demands that was/were reflected earlier but have not been addressed so far. All the four demands which are the major demands, both the other are not insignificant, were neglected earlier in B2V, and B3V, have not been addressed so far.
III	Overall assessment of visit and suggestions (The visiting officer to ensure that the overall assessment is recorded in detail along with concrete suggestions.) ① My earnest submission is that road connectivity of the villages of this pondichat is very poor. Of the roads are constructed through PM AAY, then meet of the problems of these poor people will ultimately be solved. ② Kindly address the problem of water supply. As the roads are under acute shortage of water supply through one the main road also be the deep the problem. ③ Relocation of monkeys, etc. in the area, a hand and ATM. ④ In self help groups are functional consisting of 200 female members. Some industry like soap making, distillation, etc. are being established for female members. At the time and again, these roads and water supply are the greatest problems of this area.
