Poor Public response and participation and lack of interest was over the zeal and response they showed in BSV1 could not be observed, as there is lack of action taken as follow up of earlier two back to village programmes for this programme to be successful and leaving work proccesed must start as soon as possible, so general public should be in their kind of programme. Increasing awareness among masses regarding PDS and capacity building of PDS workers is needed.

  2. there is an urgent need of 2 Tubewells and 5 hand pumps in Gp. water tanks should be constructed in every ward.
  3. Protection wall around schools, B-path, C-path, Fracter roads should be constructed in Gp.
  4. Carriage charges must be given to Anganwadi centres. The salary of employees also decreased after abrogation of article 370, so the matter must be addressed as soon as possible.
  5. there is an immediate need of 4-5 transformers in the Gp as the people are complaining about the low voltage.
  6. For better survival in village, there is a need to construct 2-4 foot bridges - Trila foot bridge (40mts), Kaha foot bridge (70mts) paida mohalla foot bridge (20mts), neeli mohalla foot bridge near mobile primary school (15mts.)
