During visit I observe that most of the people are unaware about different schemes of the Govt. People are using impure water and Road connectivity is not good. Also PWD department charges high rates to poor people. People are not able to pay electricity bills due to poverty. There is not a single water reservoir and water is running through

damaged pipes which causes a great threat to the people. Also there should be road connectivity from

Tral to Phalgam through / via Bughmud so that people on higher reaches get relief.

There should be one water conservation reservoir / Dam / filtration plant so that people can use water for irrigation purpose. There should be also some bore wells for irrigation purpose at different locations.
