Majority of the people belong to low income group who are daily wage earners or engaged in traditional agricultural practices with low yields. Members of Panchayat complaining about allocation of inadequate funds for developmental schemes and disproportionate distribution of funds among different wards ward wise distribution of funds/schemes was proposed. There is ample scope of horticulture especially in Panchayat well suits. Pears, citrus fruits etc. Farmers can be trained to switch over to farming on scientific pattern and necessary equipments/tools may be provided on subsidies.
