1) GENERAL ASSESSMENT OF THE VISITING OFFICER:

I	Any major complaint brought to the notice of the Visiting Officer:
•	Some households who were in Awas list since last 4-5 years but were not benefitted. They somehow managed to build their houses by taking loans from banks or some relatives to survive in the coming winter season. But they have been now deleted from the list during the latest survey. School buildings need renovations. Computer lab, matrig and other necessary equipments required.
II	Major/ urgent public demand(s) that was/were reflected earlier but have not been addressed so far:

•	Creation of PHC.
•	Transport facility to PH.
•	Widening of roads and magdamisation.
•	Creation of playground at Dandoosa and Chasigund.
•	Conversion of Dal (waterbody) into play at Chasigund.
•	Repairing of electric lines.
