① Poor response of State Bank of India Sumbal Branch. Wharfed Service Area Village funds have been voiced. Sanctioning for and creating loan. Sanctioning into accounts of beneficiaries under various schemes of the Govt. Shifting its Service Area to 5 km. Sumbal as redressal of complaints. Shifting of police jurisdiction from T. H. P. to Sumbal Police Station. On block as well as T. H. P. lies with Sumbal. 12 km away. While H. P. is 18 km away.

Sumbal H. P. is 18 km away.

II Major demand(s) that was/were reflected earlier but have not been

- ① Construction of Lining road from main road to Sumbal.
- ② Construction of Sump and renovation of old building.
- ③ Expansion of culvert.
- ④ Macadamization + upgrading of road from main road to Sumbal.
- ⑤ Addition over Sumbal road to village T. H. P.
- ⑥ Maintenance of Lar Kanal - removal of encroachments with lining wall from Sumbal.
- ⑦ Land up in Lar Kanal up to River Sumbal.
- ⑧ Construction of Public Park near Sumbal.
- ⑨ Providing of Electric Transformer (RA) for Sumbal, M. T. Sumbal, Sumbal and Sumbal.
