Overall functioning of the Panchayat is Satisfactory. Given the amount of work (approximately 22 nos) that has been successfully Completed in this Jalga. Since B.Vs, people showed great response and optimism towards B.Vs. In the Capacity of the Visiting officer of the Captioned Panchayat Jalga I would like to draw the attention of the administration towards some pressing needs which require special and immediate Attention. As this is a Border Area and given the tension and periodic exchange of fires between the two sides, there is a need of Construction of Underground bunkers which will aid people in those Unfortunate times. This area is also flood-prone, a number of floods have already created havoc in the past forcing people to elude the place. Hence there is a pressing need for some Constructive steps against floods. One thing which most people Complained about is that even though the majority of the population living in the area are labourers, still they have been allotted APL Ration cards. Hence there is a pressing and Genuine demand of people that they must be allotted BPL, AAY, or PHH Ration cards so that they can also take benefit of various schemes offered by the government for the above mentioned classes. There is also a need to replace all old and faulty water pipes and wooden poles used for electricity. Fencing against wild animals which damage their crop and livestock is also among the priorities.
