NO headstays projects has been made to provide the pft. with its own package of har and Playfield.

Overall assessment of visit and suggestions:

The visiting officer to ensure that the overall assessment is recorded in detail along with concrete suggestions.)

Rainion Lower being a new package after its separation from ~~Upper~~ Rainion, needs infrastructure in all fields. Priority being construction of package of har, Playfield, provision of new additional fingerbed centres; improvement of P.H.E network, Electric network and Irrigation network. All record keeping, health, social welfare dept. needs to be separated from previous package and provided to package officials.
