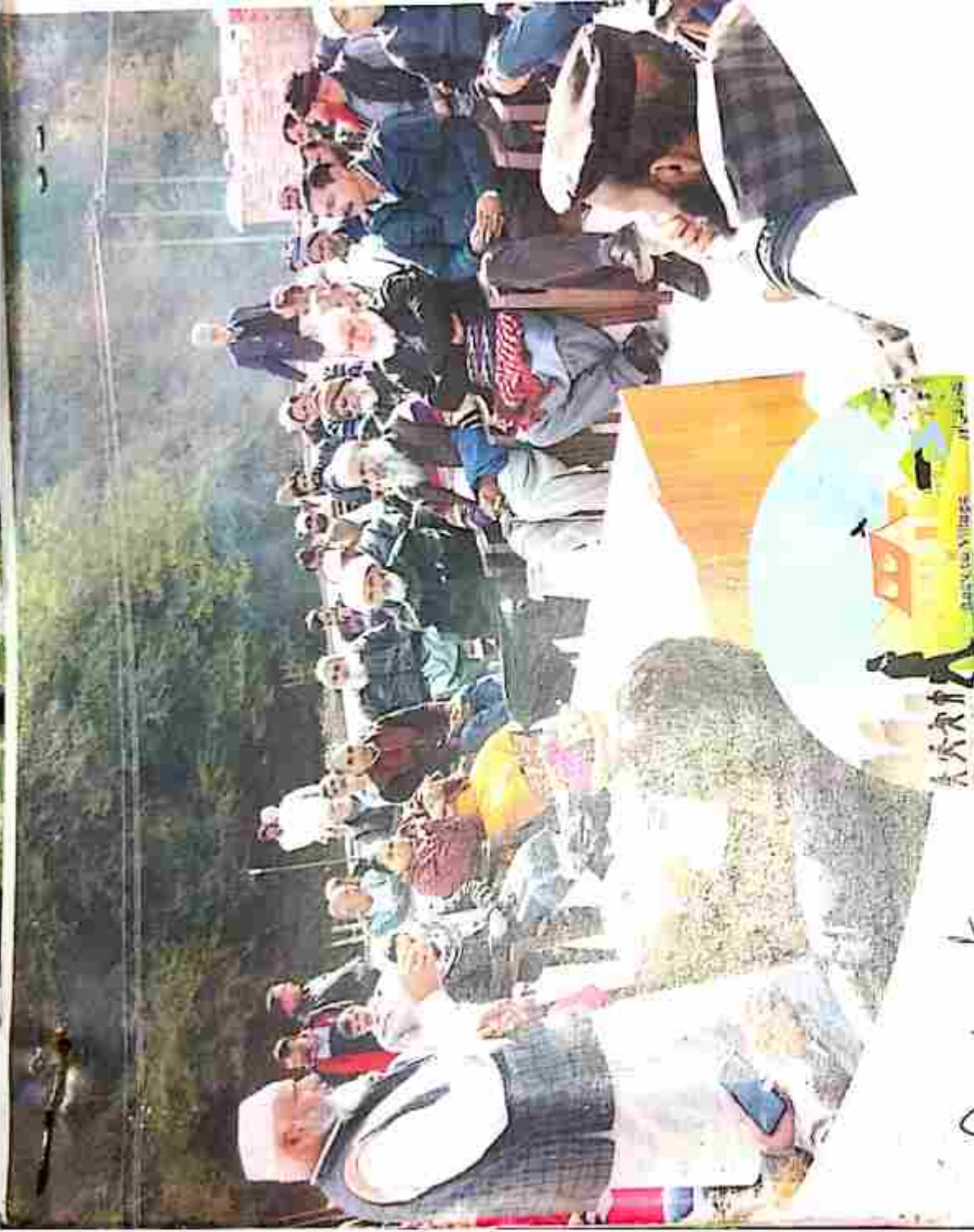
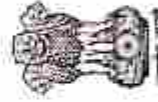

GENERAL ASSESSMENT OF THE VISITING OFFICER:

I	Any major complaint brought to the notice of the Visiting Officer. Garh Bysantric Dispensary is without adequate staff & drugs to health issues of about 2000 people in the Panchayat. Only one Junior Pharmacist (Jr) is presently posted in the dispensary. Public demanded opening of full fledged dispensary for health care of the people who have to travel long distance on foot and then by road to reach Ramnagar & Udhampur for getting health problems attended and in case of emergency, patients have to wait for worst of health care. Secondly road from Chowki to Katwail is in pathetic condition due to which employees and public face hardships to visit their place of duties and work. The road has not been repaired and black topped despite this place of duties and work. <i>Respected Sir,</i>
II	Major/ urgent public demand(s) that was/were reflected earlier but have not been addressed so far. i. Repair and black topping of Chowki-Katwail Road. ii. Completion of Road from Nikar to Katwail to connect it with Sullian-Katwail Road constructed by PMGSY. iii. Public have to carry head loads on steep hills to reach their homes and work due to no in ke connectivity of roads in Panchayat with roads. There is need for construction of bridges on Nallahs for safe and smooth flow of public during rainy season especially students. There is need of High mast light at Ben Stand and also at provision of Solar Lights at religious places for benefit of the public. Last but not least repair and black topping of Chowki-Katwail Road is urgently needed to mitigate problems of public and transporters.
