I	<p>Any major complaint brought to the notice of the Visiting Officer:</p> <p>Public of Pst. Lhami complaint that no officer of any Deptt. bother to pay visit in the Panchayat to listen the problems of the people and trace their solution. Many welfare schemes for the upliftment of the people are launched by the Govt. but proved futile because of the unawareness. Lack of seed and fertilizer. Incomplete BARR building of Govt. Milk Lohar. Ward No 4, 5, 6, and 9 are totally unconnected from road. Being far-flung area there is no PHC/Sub-centre. Demand for opening of Sub-centre at Khajoor Dhara and Lohar.</p>
II	<p>Major/ urgent public demand(s) that was/were reflected earlier but have not been addressed so far:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Road connection from: Chalas Lali to HS Khajoor Dhara; Mohalla Choudharies to Jandi Dhara; Mohalla Kalim to Mohalla Behkon. Khor-Dhara to Lujjaram-Lakhram; Tractor road from Dhara to Peet Baba to Moh. Lakhram. = upgradation of LMS Dhara to high school and sub-centre (health) to PHC. = opening of public distribution store at upper Lhami. = construction of water tank at 03, 05 and 06 ward. = opening of cutting and tailoring centre at Lhami and Dhara. = poles and wire for uncovered habitation/household. = opening of Animal husbandry centre at Lhami upper.

	<p>Panchayat Lhami Dhara is really a remote and far-flung area, not well connected with road. People are poor and also lack the basic facilities of life like drinking water; electricity; education; roads; and health facilities. Literacy rate is low. People are not fully aware of about the scientific management in agriculture and allied deptts.</p> <p>Awareness camp of various schemes in agriculture, Horticulture, Sheep husbandry and RDD deptts are organized. Govt. and district administration need a lot of focus to improve the livelihood of people living in area.</p>
