D GENERAL ASSESSMENT OF THE VISITING OFFICER:

I	Any major complaint brought to the notice of the Visiting Officer: one of the major complaint of the Panchayat / Barpach / Panchayat of G.P. were irregular supply of water in almost all wards of G.P. People were very annoyed against Govt. employees working in Panchayat as they required regular supply of electricity, water and telephone service but none of them requirement were fulfilled. More over they also complaint one of the requirement of electricity, bracket path, brick roads, hand pumps, school building and require ground with boundary wall. The people of G.P. were very in the fear of Nafay.
II	Major/ urgent public demand(s) that was/were reflected earlier but have not been addressed so far: There are many demands of the people but major and general demands which were not addressed so far are - 1. Regular supply of water (Demanded minimum with capacity 50000) 2. Regular supply of electricity (Require minimum station) 3. At least 9 nos of transformer with capacity 100 kV = 3 100 kV = 3 100 kV = 3 4. There are two historical temples one chandaboli wali and one in Raja Mallesh temple. Both of them required fund for repair of its building wall and roof.
III	Overall assessment of visit and suggestions: (The visiting officer to ensure that the overall assessment is recorded in detail along with concrete suggestions) over all assessment of the Panchayat is that Panchayat is surrounded almost 2.5 km from Batah to Bhangal (9 wards) and the living standard of the people is not so good as they required basic requirement like electricity, water supply, road, education etc. which is not in good. Govt. should take prompt action for the betterment of the people by constructing their street, hand pump, brick path, hand pumps and boundary wall of school so that the Panchayat may be able.
