I) GENERAL ASSESSMENT OF THE VISITING OFFICER.

Any major complaint brought to the notice of the Visiting Officer:

1. Replacement of lambaradar as he resides at baroti block and not in the village. He is an old man of 80 years old & is not able to perform his job. The first resolution to replace him had been submitted in 2017. D.C. Boda is attached herewith.
2. Payments for medical have not been made since long.
3. Scarcity of water
4. Bad condition of road.

Major/ urgent public demand(s) that was/were reflected earlier but have not been addressed so far:

1. Scarcity of water
2. Replacement of rotten wooden poles and barked wire for supply of electricity.
3. Bad condition of talukas to cluster road.

Overall assessment of visit and suggestions:
(The visiting officer to ensure that the overall assessment is recorded in detail along with concrete suggestions.)

1. The demand for replacement of lambaradar is genuine as he is an old man of 80 years and so he could not attend every gram sabha at cluster during B2V3 on 06-10-2020 w.e.f. 05-10-2020 to 09-10-2020. Hence the old man should be replaced in the interest of the general public & lambaradar.
2. The rotten pipes supplying water be replaced.
3. The replacement by rotten wooden poles and barked wire used for supplying electricity is hardly recommended.
4. The authority constructing talukas - cluster road may kindly be instructed to look after the road and improve it in such a manner that public may not suffer.
