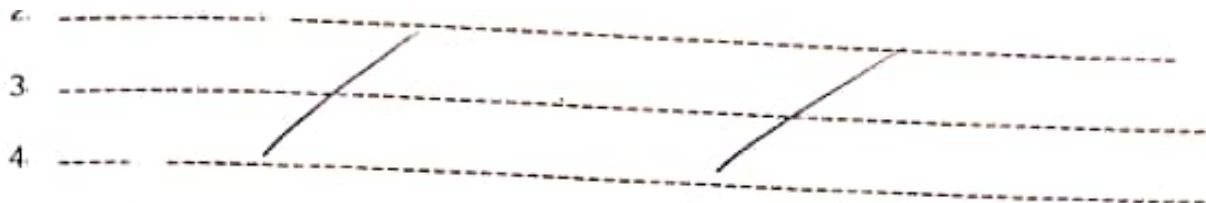

I	Any major complaint brought to the notice of the Visiting Officer:
① →	Major complaint was regarding PHE. There is acute shortage of drinking water in ward no-02 and 07. Huge crises arises when JE and other employees of PHE department come in the gram-sabha, the general public got violent and walked-out of gram-sabha. They alleged that employees are making false promises.
② →	Second complaint was regarding PDD. There is huge dearth of Electric poles and wires. The wires are hanging close to ground it needs tightening. Trees and houses are mostly used for support.
II	Major/ urgent public demand(s) that was/were reflected earlier but have not been addressed so far.
①	Drinking water crises of ward no-02 and 07 needs immediate redressal.
②	PHC and BMS needs upgradation.
③	Humsa irrigation canal needs to be restored from illegal encroachment.
④	Angan-Wardi Centre needs to be established in ward-07 i.e. Wani Mohalla.
⑤	Boze-well 05 in no. needs to be sanctioned immediately.
⑥	A Separat Ghat i.e. Food store needs to be established in ward-06 without effecting or shifting Ghat already present.
III	Overall assessment of visit and suggestions: (The visiting officer to ensure that the overall assessment is recorded in detail along with concrete suggestions.)
	Panchayat body needs to be educated and trained so that they would work together with concerned departments for upliftment of this rural area. The UPD found least co-ordination and lack of respect/trust between panchayat body due to which general public suffers. This needs to be restored by effective guidance and counselling of panchayat body from time to time.
