III Overall assessment of visit and suggestions (The visiting officer to ensure that the overall assessment is recorded in detail along with concrete suggestions)

1. As it is seen that the main problem being faced by the village is non availability of roads, which creates the residents to live in pre-war conditions. Non availability of electricity increases their problems and creates non availability of health centres.
