II GENERAL ASSESSMENT OF THE VISITING OFFICER:

Any major complaint brought to the notice of the Visiting Officer:

1. Govt. Primary School kate is without roof from last 4 years & students are shifted to G.G.M.S. which is about 11 km away from P/S kate. 1/2 Child's health Building students sit in the open sky.

2. Gulman Hahlela without electricity.

3. In Ward No. 1, only one connection of water supply.

4. No Health Sub-Centre in the Panchayat and surrounding area.

5. No Bank Branch in the area.

6. No Animal Centre available in Panchayat.

7. Repair of electricity wires and poles in the Panchayat is major complaint.

II Major urgent public demand(s) that was/were reflected earlier but have not been addressed so far:

Health: Burning need of PHC in the Panchayat to meet the emergencies and care of Pregnant women and children, improve health services effectively. ASHA workers are lacking knowledge schemes.

Bank Branch: As there is no Bank Branch nearby area the people have to go to withdraw even hundred rupees after covering a distance of 30 kilometer at least. It is a burning need of the people for opening a branch of G.G.M.S. Middle school to High school.

III Overall assessment of visit and suggestions:

(The visiting officer to ensure that the overall assessment is recorded in detail along with concrete suggestions.)

Due to the non-availability of the health facility in Panchayat health of people especially the Pregnant women and other health related emergencies the life of people at high risk. Still many people are not fully aware about the Govt. schemes. All schools in the Panchayat are lack of infrastructure and shortage of staff which is immediate need of the schools to provide infrastructure and as many of the schools are without roof for sports activities in the schools grounds are not available or available not properly developed. Therefore it is urgent need to provide all the infrastructure in the schools and Govt. school many post of lect. and teacher are lying vacant many filled immediately. In the Panchayat there is ration department but there is no building to store the ration. Hence building for the Ration should be constructed.

NOTES

The visit was done in a very smooth and cordial atmosphere. PRI members are quite co-operative and responsive. The public of the area is also very good. The over all problems of the area is due to lack of road connectivity. Drinking water facilities are still not improved irregular water supply in the area because of insufficient water tanks in the area. Electricity wires and poles are not provided in the Panchayat at many location wires are knitted with trees and some where people have made their own arrangement by wooden poles of dried trees which is a great threat for the people of area at any time there can be short circuit and life of the people is at high risk. My suggestion and public demands that the wires and poles may immediately be replaced and new one installed. As to higher sec. school library rate is quite good and govt employment is quite satisfactory. Peoples are not fully satisfied the B2V2 as most of the many demands are not being addressed but hoping that B2V3 will bring some positive result for them and that their demands will be fulfilled. The Panchayat is functioning satisfactorily. The gram sabhas and regular meetings are conducted. The record is well maintained all PRI members are quite popular in the area and have good projection of the problem. Over all PRI members and public of the Panchayat is very cooperative.
