People of Panchayat had great hopes in B2V1, B2V2 and even today in B2V3 but their faith is being lost constantly from the authorities. Concerned demands projected in the previous Back to villages have not been completed and even not been started. They have very genuine grievances especially with regard to internal connectivity, drinking water electricity etc. as mentioned above. <u>Suggestions:</u> ① frequent visits of officials of all dept. are required in the P ② Road Connectivity / drinking water must be taken into consideration on Priority Basis. ③ People of locality are very innovative and creative but proper guidance / training in different sector are required.
