I Any major complaint brought to the notice of the Visiting Officer:
 There is great resentment among peoples against PDD and PHE Deptt. PDD fails to provide electric polls and PHE fails to provide poteable water in all wards of Panchayat. There is leakage in water supply lines in various places. Moreover, there is acute shortage of drinking water in Kanthi, Bhalwana, Dachalla and Bangaru.

- Construction of Panchayat Shor at Bhalwana.
- construction of road from Barshalla to Bhalwana.
- Upgradation of Gort. UPS Bhalwana to the level of high school.

- Construction of water reservoir for Bharate, Bhanwal and Gupar Basti.
- Water lifting scheme from Chenab for irrigation purpose
- Construction of Cremation shed at cremation ground Bhalwana and Bharate.

III Overall assessment of visit and suggestions:

As visiting officer I received full cooperation from PRI's and public. Peoples participated in Gram Sabha in large and enthusiastically to put their demands. Healthy discussions were held. Majority of the peoples were angry as their demands were not taken seriously. Most of the basic needs of life like poteable water supply, electric polls, health care facilities, road connectivity not available. The main cause for all these is Apathetic attitude of Gort. officials, lack of Grievance Redressal Mechanism and lack of awareness contributed much to their sufferings. I would suggest provide basic

facilities on priority bases. Upgrade UPS to high school as students have to travel 10km to attend classes after middle school. Construction of Panchayat Shor, Establishment of Branch of Bank, construction playground, water lifting scheme from Chenab and release payments for 2016-2017 and 2017-18.
