II	Major/ urgent public demands) that was/were reflected earlier but have not been addressed so far.
1	① Demand for about 200 electric poles for the Panchayat.
2	② To increase coverage of piped water supply, in houses not yet covered. Besides, duration of supply need to be increased.
3	③ Water pumping station needed to be connected with new receiving station to solve the electric-supply issues.
4	④ Strong demand for play-ground in the Panchayat and sports-kits and uniforms.
III	Overall assessment of visit and suggestions: (The visiting officer to ensure that the overall assessment is recorded in detail along with concrete suggestions.)
→ Panchayat is presently functioning from private house of the Sarpanch. The building constructed about 15 years back is presently lying unused mainly because of lack of road connectivity. It is strongly recommended that proper road (approx. 200m) should be constructed by G.E.B. The building can be repaired from available funds under 15th Finance Commission and Panchayat should function from there. → Revenue Dept. should provide Khatwani/Stat land near Panchayat for development of play-ground. → Panchayat is blessed with a good network of water channels/springs but unfortunately household/other wastes are being dumped by households. Panchayat should create awareness and rejuvenate/protect these water bodies.
