Road in chaudi Mohalla and Road Dadka Mohalla and also PHE pipes chaudi to local changed. Angadwadi central Dalt Poldi Building required also in other centres. Boundary wall and playground at govt high school Jansal. Required Hand Pump need in all wards.

Passenger shed need at Narsingh Temple, Khawoo Chandi Mata w.no 3 Jansal to Vankhal Pater via Harupur Road need under ^{Bara, Bara} road connectivity. Road to Dhanua via Mohalla ^{Bara, Bara} and Sural approx 4 km. ^{Bara, Bara} Road to Dalt w.no approx 2 km, ^{Bara, Bara} Road PMGSY to ^{Bara, Bara} Jansal. Incomplete approx 1 km distance.

II Major/ urgent public demand(s) that was/were reflected earlier but have not been addressed so far:

III Overall assessment of visit and suggestions:

People of Panchayat including Panches & Sarpanch are very cooperative but they are very annoyed because their problems which are reflected during B2V1 & B2V2 programmes are not solved upto this time. Only one problem is solved which is installation of transformer in w.no 2 Mohalla, Janakhar. All the schemes of govt are excellent but not implementation at ground level are very poor. It is submitted that genuine demands of the Panchayat which are raised B2V1, B2V2, programme may be addressed/solved in the phase "manner" for the benefit of people of the Panchayat. The people of Panchayat very hopeful that visiting officers will be overall incharge of this Panchayat during the working.
