As a visiting officer to Panchayat Dangers I have found that most of basic needs of life like water supply, electricity, health care, Animal and Sheep Husbandary facilities are not available upto the most in the said Panchayat.

Many peoples including Sarpanch and Panches complained about unavailability of these facilities and how much they are suffering because of this.

Apathetic attitude of Govt. officers, lack of grievances redressal mechanism, lack of awareness, contributed much of this suffering of Gov. public.

As a visiting officer, I would like suggest the following:-

1. Provide basic facilities like potable water supply, Electricity, health care, Sheep and Animal Husbandary on priority basis.
2. Increase awareness of Govt. public to wards their rights.
3. Poultry Dept should aware the peoples about the benefits of poultry, fowls.
4. Animal Husbandary Dept should aware the peoples about the dairy farming and which breeds of Animal is good for dairy farming.
5. Sheep Husbandary Dept should aware the peoples about sheep units.
6. Agric. Dept should aware the peoples about the cropping pattern of HYV seeds and which season is good for sowing.
