Major Public demands

1. In no. 6, MPS Bankot has a total strength of 45 students but no teacher for last two years.
2. Primary school Bankot is closed since 1998 due to militant attack but is still closed & has a strength of 117.
3. Only one teacher is deployed in PS Sian, no building or school.
4. There is no ration depot in this area & people have to travel 30 km on foot to get ration.
5. Panchayat is without water supply. Tenders should be cleared at the earliest.
6. Panchayat Ghar is needed in panchayat.
7. PMAY is applicable to whole panchayat but only two houses sanctioned.
8. Sub center of health which is shifted to Tallwara should be reverted.
9. VDC were formed on 2nd Feb 2005 but no honorarium is paid to them till date.
10. Tractor road from Kanili Bachha to Shaktikot under PWD should be constructed.
11. Bridge measuring 50 feet at Dmli still W.No. 1 is urgent requirement.
12. Bridge measuring 40 feet at Talu pari should be constructed.
13. Road measuring 10 km from Markanad to Mohra Shaktikot.
14. Medical subcenter at Mohra Bada Ban.
15. There is one chowkidar for five villages. Separate chowkidar should be appointed for Shaktikot.
16. The Bank extension Counter (BEC) is urgent requirement of the area.
17. 11 persons were employed by PHE on daily wages but were expelled due to online registration failure.
18. One anganwadi centre is required in every ward W.No. 2, 3, 5 & 6 are without AWCs.
19. Whole panchayat is not electrified.
