I	Any major complaint brought to the notice of the visiting officer
①	Poor quality of drinking water in Village Angama. The production well of the existing water supply scheme "Angama" has gone dry [As reported by the officials of the concerned department], resulting in low production and bad quality of drinking water. Construction of a new production well at some alternate location will soon address the problem.
②	Resurfacing of road from Budanpura to Kalamia via Bawal has not been undertaken since years although land cover is already disturbed to the land owners by the Govt. (Major urban public demand) that machines affected water has have not been addressed so far.
③	Development of Targation Canal (Corridor of water) especially around passing through Village Angama (from Chak Jangana to Kalamia).
④	Replacement of wooden electric poles with steel tubular poles in Narainpura Budanpura and Kalamia Villages of the Haly.
⑤	Macadamization / Black topping of inner roads (about 11 km).
⑥	Up-gradation of Sub-canal to PHC, and repairs of boundary walls and wash rooms of existing Sub-canal 4 km.
⑦	Fencing of Play ground at Narainpura.
II	Overall assessment of visit and suggestions: (The visiting officer to ensure that the overall assessment is recorded in detail along with concrete suggestions.)
	A greater public participation as was expected could not be seen, probably because of non-availability of Panchayat resulting in the fact that people are mostly unaware about the govt. policies especially the Beneficiary Schemes. Area being mostly associated with Agriculture, Poultry, Dairying and Handicrafts, the department schemes (more oriented) need to be introduced in the Area.
