GENERAL ASSESSMENT OF THE VISITING OFFICER.

Any major complaint brought to the notice of the Visiting Officer:

1. No development work has been taken up due to non co-operation of Sarpanch. Besides only one panch ward - 6 is existing and 08 wards are lying vacant.
2. An amount of Rs 32 Lakh stand sanctioned but is still unutilized though several works have been identified in B2V1 and B2V2.
3. Besides repeated assurances by Tal shakti department the old water supply pipes are not replaced which results to wastage of precious drinking water.

Major/ urgent public demand(s) that was/were reflected earlier but have not been addressed so far:

1. Replacement of old damaged water pipes by new pipes.
2. Macadamization of link roads from P/s Aboosa to house of Ab. Gani Bhat.
3. Creation of (03) ICD centres in ward no (2), (5), (6).
4. Upgradation of sub centre to PHC.
5. Construction of retention wall/fencing of P/s Lahipora.
6. Requirement of Ambulance in panchayat Halap.
7. Sanction of Fire and Emergency service to which is the dire need of the whole Tehsil.

Overall assessment of visit and suggestions:

The visiting officer to ensure that the overall assessment is recorded in detail along with concrete suggestions.)

Overall impression of public about back to village initiative by Government is not up to mark and the public response was much less than expected. It is worth to mention here that the visiting officer should be empowered and a certain amount be kept at his disposal to meet out public demands on spot. As been observed that the frontline workers are serious and concerned departments are not active during B2V flagship programme of the government.
