department of PMGSY regarding damage done
on water pipes supplying water and not providing
Protection Bunds for their land and
houses which get eroded due to
construction of roads through the area.

During the visit most of the people are of the opinion that it takes lot of time in getting the wrong sanctioned / estimation and their timely completion which put main hurdle in the development of the area.
