1) GENERAL ASSESSMENT OF THE VISITING OFFICER:

I	Any major complaint brought to the notice of the Visiting Officer:
	The major complaints of the Gram Panchayat include shortage of drinking water, shortage of electric poles and connecting wires, lack of all weather links and a health center with all healthcare facilities.
II	Major/ urgent public demand(s) that was/were reflected earlier but have not been addressed so far:
	The most urgent nature of demand from the G.P. is the supply of portable drinking water. The entire population is getting drinking water from a single public post near Govt. High School which is not sufficient for an estimated population of about 5000 souls. It is pertinent to mention that though the G.P. falls within the territorial jurisdiction of Baramulla District, but water supply to the single public post is being provided by District Panchayat, which is itself speaks about the negligence being done towards G.P. The issue needs to be taken up on work footing basis to redress the grievance of public.
III	Overall assessment of visit and suggestions: (The visiting officer to ensure that the overall assessment is recorded in detail along with concrete suggestions.)
	The Gram Panchayat is overall is partially developed with most of the development works being undertaken by Rural Dev Deptt only. The gram Panchayat has not been brought under portable water supply till date, which gives an insight into the presence of other line departments in the G.P. The health subcenter is operating from a rented accommodation that too situated in a cow-shed. There is a need for change into its own accommodation and latest diagnostics. The face of the inner links need to be made all weather to up-lift the overall appearance of the G.P.
