1) GENERAL ASSESSMENT OF THE VISITING OFFICER:

I Any major complaint brought to the notice of the Visiting Officer:

1. There is scarcity of drinking water particularly during summer. Bore well of 12" urgently required as dug well dried up during summer.

2. Dilapidated condition of road network in Lanchayat. and even main road has not been maintained and upgraded in spite of demands being projected under B2-V1 + B2V2.

II Major/ urgent public demand(s) that was/were reflected earlier but have not been addressed so far:

a) Construction of deep Bore well 12" so that drinking water supply could be maintained throughout the year. The dug well available in P.Y. dried up during summer and people facing hardships for want of drinking water.

b) Dilapidated condition of road and even main road to Jamthian has not been maintained since 1990.

c) Bridge over Gorgai Nallah to maintain connectivity between Jamthian & Manam.

III Overall assessment of visit and suggestions:
(The visiting officer to ensure that the overall assessment is recorded in detail along with concrete suggestions.)

- (i) There is poor condition of water supply as the infrastructure developed by DHE is not properly working due to low water table as dug well dried up during summer. Therefore Bore well upto depth of permanent water table should be constructed.
- (ii) There is dilapidated condition of main road to Jamthian which should be maintained/upgraded to improve the socio-economic condition of people.
- (iii) The DHE is urgently required as health facilities are not available in the Lanchayat.
- (iv) The Govt middle school Jamthian should be upgraded to High School.

(v) Panchayat dispensary is urgently required as health facilities are not available in the Lanchayat.
