NOTES

- ① During the visit of wards through Lilly-lensain, the electric wires were seen at low heights of 4' or 6' due to long spans between the poles. Moreover some poles were seen damaged and there is a large threat to the human lives of the village. There is need to maintain the electric system properly.
- ② Regarding drinking water supply, there is great problem to the people as the progress of ongoing PHE scheme Bunge-Bhaywa is very slow. Presently few houses are getting the drinking water from the small gravity schemes and other 90% population is carrying water through shoulders or heads from far off vallahes or bowlies to meet their requirement. However during summer these sources also become dry and people suffer the scarcity of water.
- ③ The only road from Lohoru bridge to Dhardynroseri is in dilapidated condition and this is the ~~same~~ source of transportation and conveyance to the employees and General Public. This 7 km stretch of the Road needs immediate Upgradation by the PWD.
- ④ There is need of construction of small bath rooms for ladies near the existing Water Bowlies besides ladies Sanitary complexes near P.S. School Metadoor Bus Stand.
