

I) GENERAL ASSESSMENT OF THE VISITING OFFICER:

I	Any major complaint brought to the notice of the Visiting Officer:
01	The people complained regarding upgradation of Govt. BMS Dooniwari neglected which has been established in 1954.
02	People complained that the dept. is delaying in completion of water supply scheme Kauphpora Dooniwari. the progress of work is very very slow. people are suffering badly.
03	People complained that the PDD Depart. have installed transmission lines on wooden poles which is a great threat for lives.
4	Major population of Dooniwari panchayat is populated on hill slopes which results often land slides which have great threat to residential houses.
II	Major/ urgent public demand(s) that was/were reflected earlier but have not been addressed so far:
01	Early completion of water supply scheme Kauphpora Dooniwari.
02	Completely renovation of electric system, Temporary wooden poles and damaged LT, HT Transmission lines should be replaced urgently.
03	Upgradation of Govt. BMS Dooniwari up to level of High School.
04	Const. of Panchayat Ghar while as the Govt. land is available.
05	Skill Development Centre should be established.
III	Overall assessment of visit and suggestions: (The visiting officer to ensure that the overall assessment is recorded in detail along with concrete suggestions.)
01	70% population of Dooniwari panchayat is living below poverty line, They have no any other source of income such as agriculture, horticulture or apiculture. Maximum do their livings from daily labour recommended for more central sponsored schemes to be implemented such as PMAY, MGNREGS etc.
02	The GRS working as MGNREGS Supporting Staff in Rural Development Department is performing extraordinary and commendable job at pvt level should be regularised in the concern dept. and their remuneration should be enhanced as per my assessment.
