## NOTES

During visiting various govt. offices and Gram Panchayat several complaints were registered. Most of the ICPS workers complained of inadequate honorarium, delay in salary, less rent and delay in supply of ration to the centres. The BDC chairman & inhabitants strongly urged to start anti land grab encroachment drive. During my three days visit there were not representatives from Jek Bank, Labour Department & Jek Police. Moreover I received many verbal complaints against the

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Manager of Jek Bank Nehalpur.

The overall performance of frontline workers of the GP was satisfactory. The performance of Panchayat Secretary & LKS was extraordinary.

### Suggestions

1. The problems & demands raised during B2V1 & B2V2 must be resolved at an earliest.
2. Keeping in view the huge demands of people, enough funds should be allotted to RDP, POD & PHE.
3. Information about various govt. schemes should be published through print & electronic media.
4. Emphasis should be laid on cordial relations b/w people & administration.
5. Checks and balances should be introduced.
