The major, previous demand of public was road connectivity that was not fulfilled so far.



III Overall assessment of visit and suggestions:

After visiting the whole Panchayat, I have come into the Conclusion that there is dire need of road connectivity. No development take place unless construct proper road to G.P. Behota. If road ^{get} constructed all other facilities automatically come into the Panchayat.
